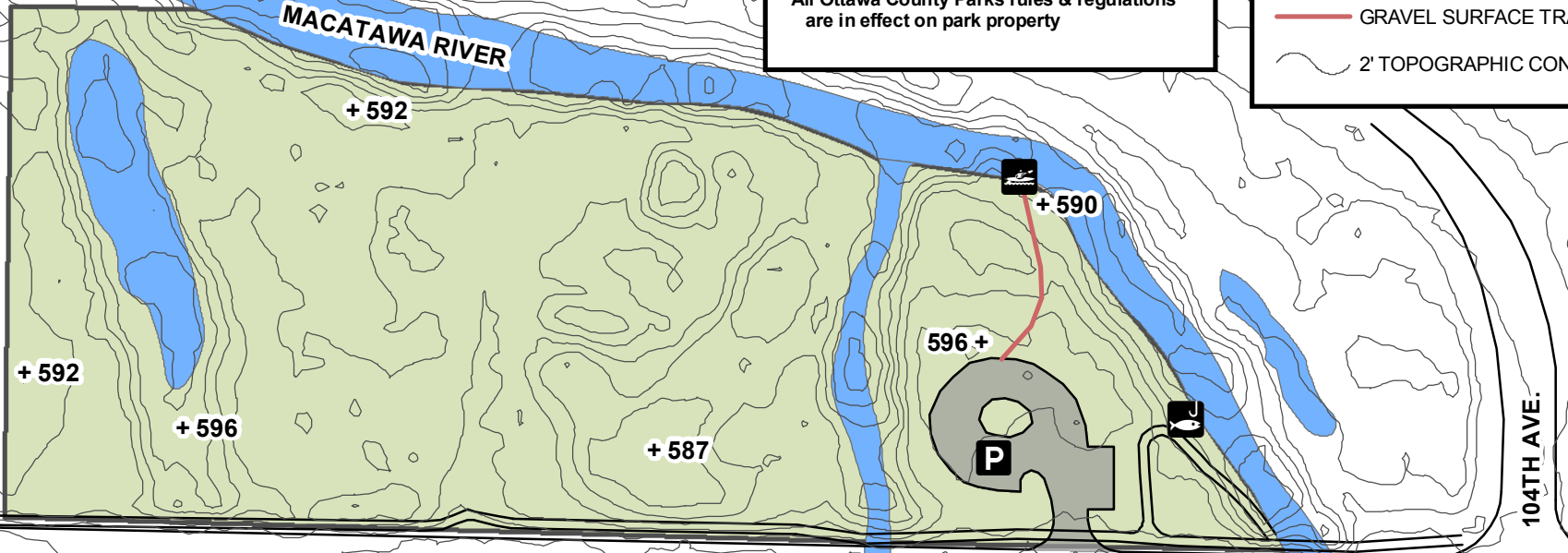

Holland, MI 49423

This 10 acre site, with mature trees and about 1,200 feet of frontage on the Macatawa River, serves as an access for fishing and picnicking as well as a launch site for canoes and kayaks. The site is also expected to be an important staging area for a future greenway trail which the Macatawa Greenway Partnership is actively working to establish along the river corridor.
